While schools are closed to Foundation Phase pupils, our teachers have been giving out books to the parents of children on our lists and also to others who are keen to keep learning to read.

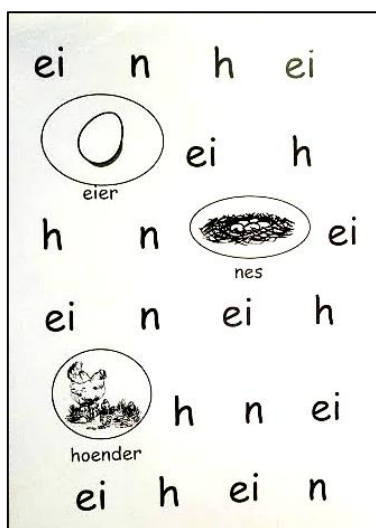

Parents are individually instructed how to help and encourage their children to read at home. We hope that their experience during this time of lockdown will see parents continuing to be more involved in helping their children with reading at home in the future, even once schools reopen.

Pupils from poor communities do not have access to online learning. All of our reading materials are easily printable and are freely available as PDF files on our website, www.fiveloavestwofish.org.za. There are sound charts, phonics exercises, and story booklets in Afrikaans, English and isiXhosa. These files can be printed at home, or e-mailed to a printing firm. Typical costs are about R10 per book.
