In spite of the many challenges that the pandemic has brought to education, the Remedial Reading Project is still going well in Klipplaat.

Our senior teacher, Mrs Bruiners, a retired Grade 2 teacher, is not allowed to go to school anymore, as she is deemed of “vulnerable age”. Nothing daunted, she has converted a spare room in her house into a classroom, seen here on the left, and now teaches from home. To achieve social distancing at school, each grade has been divided in half, and each half goes to school on alternate days. This means that on their “off” days, children are free to go to Mrs Bruiners for help with reading. This they eagerly do.

Our two young teachers-in-training, Ms Grootboom and Ms May, pictured here on the right and below, teach both at school and from home, both in the mornings and in the afternoons.



At the Klipplaat high school are two more young teachers-in-training who, like our two ladies, are studying by correspondence to become fully qualified.



Five Loaves Two Fish pays their salaries and their study fees and helps them with teaching materials where necessary.
